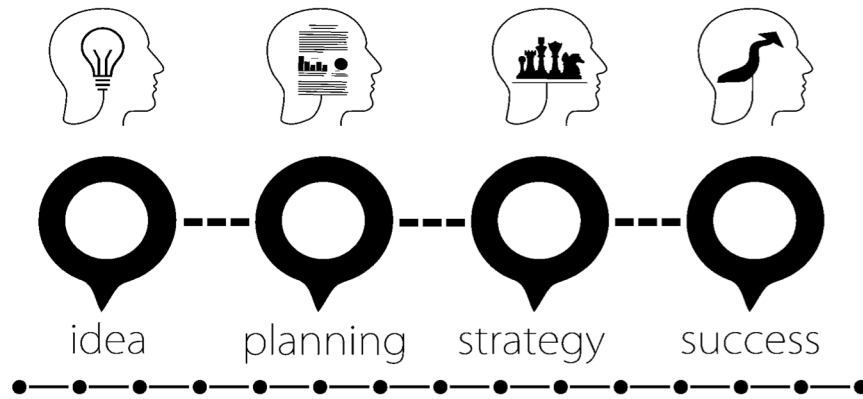


# TRANSITION TO WORK

This professional development is intended to inform school leaders (e.g. middle and high school intervention specialists, related service personnel and special education administrators) about their roles and responsibilities in improving postsecondary outcomes for students with disabilities.
